CONT. Meeting minutes for September 4, 2016:

Seneschal:

Baronial Election: This is the official call for Letters of Intent for Baron and/or Baroness. Please send your intention packet to me by the end of September. I will post the specifics from our L&P to the email group in a separate email.

Deputy Seneschal Needed – I will be stepping down at the end of next year so we need someone who is able to take over as Seneschal when the time comes. It would be wonderful to have two people trained and ready to take over as Seneschal and Deputy Seneschal at that time.

Deputy Knight Marshal – This position is still open and needs to be filled.

Exchequer: Both the 3 Day and 7 Pearls event made a profit.

Checking: \$6,019.85

Savings: \$1,812.98

A&S: Watch for information about a workshop for making Combat Archery Crossbows.

Ian will be stepping down at the end of his term in January, and Dame Vivienne will take over as A&S Officer.

Chatelaine: We would like to have another gathering at the 1889 Park similar to the Newcomers Meeting but more like a Swap Meet. More information will become available later. In the meantime, look through your “stuff” and see if

there’s anything that you think new people could use.
